TOPIC	CONTENT	TEACHER STANDARDS
<b>Safeguarding Training</b>	Safeguarding Training is one of the most important training sessions delivered. It will give you the knowledge and confidence to recognise and report concerns about pupils welfare. Your own safety is also covered.	Part 2
<b>British Values and Prevent Agenda</b>	This topic covers keeping our students safe and within the law. It covers being a British citizen and the dangers of being drawn into extreme ideologies and where to report concerns.	Part 2
<b>Staff procedures and policies at Pershore High School</b>	This session an overview of how the school systems work and your role in them.	1, 8, Part 2
<b>Pupil Shadowing - Lower and Higher ability Year 8 and 9 students</b>	Pupil shadowing is a valuable means of observing different styles of teaching in different subjects at different times of the school day and how pupils react to these differences.	
<b>Role of the Teaching Assistant</b>	This session will give you an understanding of the role of a Teaching Assistant and the importance of their role.	5, 8
<b>Shadowing a Teaching Assistant</b>	To see the work of a Teaching Assistant in practice.	
<b>Role of the SENCO and Code of Practice</b>	Who is and what is a SENCO? Looking at how the Code of Practice impacts our work with SEND.	1, 2, 5, 8, Part 2
<b>Differentiation</b>	Differentiation is the process by which differences between learners are accommodated and is now a key skill for any teacher, especially those of mixed-ability classes. Strategies for differentiating material is covered.	2, 5, 7
<b>Dealing with students with Autism</b>	We are lucky enough to have an Autism Base at Pershore High School. You will begin to understand the difficulties students with autism have to deal with in the classroom and the support you can give to enhance the education and inclusion of children with Autism. You will have an opportunity to spend time in the Autism Base during your placement should you wish to.	5
<b>How to use your voice</b>	Your voice is your most powerful teaching tool. Experienced staff will teach you how to project your voice and protect it from damage.	
<b>Extra Curricular activities</b>	What activities are on offer at school for pupils to do outside the classroom? This session will cover the importance and benefits of offering these activities.	8
<b>Middle School visit and transition</b>	Pershore High School will organise a day in a local middle school. You will be given instruction on what to look for during your visit. The process of transition of pupils from Year 7 into Year 8 at the High School is explained in this session.	1, 3
<b>Vertical Tutoring, Pastoral System, Pastoral Issues</b>	This session looks at the pastoral system in school, how it is organised and how our system of Vertical Tutoring works.	2, 6

<b>Pupil Progress and Pupil Premium</b>	How do we measure pupils progress? What is Pupil Premium and how does it affect the classroom? All is explained in this session.	2
<b>Understanding the Teaching Standards</b>	The Teacher Standards underpin everything a teacher does. What do they mean? How do we use them? All of these questions will be answered in this session.	
<b>Understanding the university paperwork - to include Evidence Folder, Standards Tracker and Recording Mentor Meetings</b>	In this session the Training Manager will spend time with you looking at your university paperwork. What is it for? How do you use it?	
<b>Lesson Planning</b>	Understanding the principles of planning a successful lesson.	2, 3, 4
<b>Classroom and Behaviour Management</b>	This session covers strategies of managing behaviour and managing the classroom.	1, 5, 7
<b>Curriculum Development, Learn2Learn and Pupil Voice</b>	This session looks at recent developments and demands on the curriculum, including Learn2Learn. This session also covers the importance of Pupil Voice and how it is used in school.	2, 3
<b>Extending Learners</b>	How to stretch and challenge your brightest pupils in the classroom.	
<b>Marking and Assessment for Learning</b>	Looking at the importance of marking, closing the gap marking and giving effective feedback.	2, 4, 6
<b>Report Writing, Communication with parents and Parents' Evenings</b>	Looking at the different forms of communication with parents including how to conduct yourself at a Parents' Evening and how to write reports.	8
